Moorpark Place is a specialist residential service for adults who are on the Autistic Spectrum. Our model of care comprises Person-Centred Plans delivered by a Multi-Disciplinary Team, including Support Workers and Therapists. Our residents can enjoy both group and individual sessions, both on and off site.

Moorpark Place is situated in a stunning and peaceful setting on the edge of the town of Kilbirnie in North Ayrshire. Our centre is just a 25 minute drive from Glasgow International Airport and close to the West coastal towns of Largs and Millport.

We support:

- Both men and women
- Aged 18 and over
- Diagnosed as being on the Autistic Spectrum

Our layout here at Moorpark Place is different to many other specialist Autism services in the UK. Our community consists of 25 individual houses set in their own grounds with some shared communal facilities.

With this arrangement our residents can enjoy all aspects of individual living whilst being part of a smaller community.

With their own dedicated and experienced staff, our residents are encouraged to participate as much as possible in the development of their own Person-Centred Care Plans. Care Plans can look very different for each person depending upon their own goals and interests and family involvement.



We warmly welcome help from families and friends in the development of these Care Plans to ensure that each one is meaningful for the individual.

We are fully accredited by the National Autistic Society to ensure that our residents receive specialist support and the highest standard of care for everyday living.

Care Inspectorate

Our service is regulated by the Care Inspectorate. In their latest inspection report Moorpark Place was rated “very good” overall.

We offer a range of onsite therapies including Speech and Language Therapy, Occupational Therapy and Clinical Psychology.

We are always looking to add new activities to help our residents develop and gain new skills.

Our Care

Our service is managed by a Registered Manager who is assisted by two Deputy Managers. Along with a number of other personnel, they are responsible for the day-to-day running of the service and the development of the service to meet the changing needs of the residents.

We have a Clinical Lead Psychologist on site as well as an Occupational Therapist and a Speech and Language Therapist. We also have administration, housekeeping and maintenance staff.

We have excellent links with our local Community Learning Disability Team : the Charge Nurse and Consultant Psychiatrist regularly attend our Multi- Disciplinary Team meetings and visit the residents onsite.

Our dedicated team receive an initial two week induction training and regular face-to-face training throughout the year.
