

Your guide to

Nottingham Brain Injury Rehabilitation and Neurological Care Centre



At Nottingham Brain Injury Rehabilitation and Neurological Care Centre, we offer rehabilitation, care and support to adults, both male and female, with a brain injury or other neurological condition. Residents stay with us either on an inpatient or day care basis.

Our service is for adults who are medically stable, with a range of neurological conditions such as:

- Acquired and traumatic brain injury
- Stroke
- Huntington's Disease
- Multiple Sclerosis
- Motor Neurone Disease
- Spinal Injury
- Epilepsy

We can support individuals with tracheostomy care, enteral feeding and assisted ventilation. We also provide assessment for individuals in low states of arousal who require a SMART (Sensory Modality Assessment and Rehabilitation) assessment. There are three interconnecting buildings on our site, known as Rosewood, Fernwood and Millwood. They each offer a different service.

Millwood (22 beds)

Millwood is the setting for our slow stream rehabilitation service. We provide a range of rehabilitation therapies to help people relearn and practice everyday skills to give them the best chance of a return back home.

Rosewood (29 beds)

Rosewood is our service for individuals with complex disabilities who are not able to live at home either because of the high level of nursing care they need or because they have ongoing rehabilitation needs.



Fernwood (20 beds)

Fernwood is our high dependency service where we look after individuals with particularly complex nursing care needs. Residents may, for example, have tracheostomies, require assisted ventilation or may be minimally conscious. We also care for individuals who may be in the end stages of a progressive neurological illness.

Across the three units, we also offer a respite care and a day care service.

Respite Care

We offer respite care, for several days or several weeks. This not only give carers a break but also provides an opportunity for the person they care for to have a change of scene and access to our therapeutic and social activities. We can also use this time to reassess an individual and provide some practical suggestions for their ongoing care at home.

Day Care

This is an option for individuals living at home or in the community who, from time to time, wish to join us during the day for one or two days a week to either have some therapy or just to meet others and join in with the social activities on offer. People can choose to pay for respite or day care themselves or use personal health care budget allowances.

Our Care

Every person who enters our service is treated as an individual with their own very specific, and often complex care needs. We take a multi-disciplinary collaborative approach, responding to residents, their families, referrers and other professionals.

Our team provide a high level of support and care by creating individualised person-centred treatment packages in a safe, therapeutic environment. Members of our multi-disciplinary team include a Service Director, Consultant in Clinical Psychology, Speech and Language Therapists, Occupational Therapists, Physiotherapists and Specialist Nurses and Rehabilitation Assistants.

Our clinical team is supported by three unit managers, activity therapists and a team of housekeeping, catering, maintenance and administration staff.
