The Huntercombe Centre Redbourne



The Huntercombe Centre Redbourne is a specialist care home providing supportive, therapeutic care for men (18+) with a Mental Health Condition, Learning Disability or Autistic Spectrum Disorder. The nursing team is also available to support individuals who also suffer with associated physical health conditions.

Situated in a rural environment in the peaceful Lincolnshire countryside our centre is close to the towns of Brigg (7 miles) and Scunthorpe (10 miles) and is only 20 miles from the city of Lincoln. We offer a homely, welcoming environment conducive to the wellbeing of our residents, some of whom live with us permanently, others who simply stay for a short period of time before moving on.

Our service is suitable for men over the age of 18 years diagnosed with:

- A mental health condition such as bipolar disorder
- A Learning Disability, Autism or Autistic Spectrum Disorder
- Either of the above with a longterm physical condition such as epilepsy or diabetes



We accept residents who are 'informal' or who are on a community treatment order or guardianship. Before admitting anyone to our centre we always make sure that they will fit in well with our existing residents and be willing to join in with the activities on offer.

We support our residents to gain skills and coping strategies to help them live with or overcome the challenges posed by their illness or condition.

Developing skills not only builds confidence but also encourages self-esteem. That's why we don't just focus on self care and daily living skills, we also look at building confidence through the learning of new skills such as arts and crafts, gardening or computer skills and community engagement.

We are able to provide a range of flexible support options enabling residents to stay with us either longterm or as part of a short-term "step down" pathway.

However long a resident chooses to stay with us, our aim is always to equip them with the skills needed to enable them to live in a more independent environment.

We achieve this by listening to our residents, their families or carers and other professionals involved in their care to gain a clear picture of the person we are caring for. Together we create a care plan tailored to each person with clear goals and milestones.

Our Care

Our centre is managed by a centre manager who is supported by a team dedicated to giving the best care and support to our residents.

Our nurses are trained as Mental Health or Learning Disability Nurses. The nurses and team of support workers are highly experienced in working with adults with mental health, learning disability, other complex care needs and associated medical conditions such as epilepsy and diabetes.

We can also organise for individual residents to see a psychiatrist or clinical psychologist if required. All our residents are registered under the care of our local GP for general health care needs. We may also be able to offer respite care or day care following an assessment of needs.
