Stocksbridge Brain Injury Rehabilitation and Neurological Care Centre



At Stocksbridge Brain Injury and Neurological Care Centre, we offer rehabilitation, care and support to adults, both male and female, with a brain injury or other neurological condition.

Set high in the Pennine hills and just 12 miles North West of Sheffield, the town of Stocksbridge borders the Peak District and is surrounded by spectacular countryside with wonderful views but close and easy access to both Sheffield and Barnsley.

Our service is for adults (18+), who are medically stable, with a range of neurological conditions such as:

- Acquired or traumatic brain injury
- Multiple Sclerosis
- Motor Neurone Disease
- Guillain-Barre Syndrome
- Stroke
- Spinal Injury

We also admit adults with PEGS or tracheostomies and patients who require assisted ventilation or hoist.

We can also accommodate patients who are in low states of arousal and who require a SMART (Sensory Modality Assessment and Rehabilitation Technique) assessment.

We provide a range of services including assessment, rehabilitation, residential care and respite care.

Rehabilitation Service

This service is suitable for individuals who have either completed a period of intense or Level 1 rehabilitation and have ongoing active therapy needs, or have less complex rehabilitation and care requirements. In either situation, patients have the potential to improve to either enable a return home or to a community setting with reduced future care needs.

Residential Care Service

This service is for those individuals who have ongoing problems associated with either a brain injury or other neurological condition and who cannot be cared for at home, usually because of the high level of nursing care they need. Patients may also need regular medical investigations or monitoring which are not easy to manage in a normal residential home or their own home.

Inpatient Assessment Service

This service is available to those who require a short inpatient stay (two -ten weeks) in order to undergo an assessment of their condition, after which recommendations for future treatment and care can be made.

Respite Care

A short stay at Stocksbridge is available for those individuals who live at home but who could benefit from a change of scene. It also offers a much needed break for families and carers and is an opportunity to have their care needs reassessed.

The team at Stocksbridge is managed by Jill Salmon, Centre Manager. She is supported by a full multi-disciplinary team which includes specialists in psychology, physiotherapy, occupational therapy, speech and language therapy and nursing.

As well as the clinical team, Jill is also supported by a team of housekeeping, catering, maintenance and administration staff.
